



Mercy University will award three (3) semester hours of graduate credit for courses offered by Teacher Education Institute & Mercy University that are successfully completed. All Participants must have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree in order to receive graduate credit. An official transcript, if requested, will be issued upon course completion.

TEI courses are part of the Mercy University graduate catalog. TEI courses may be accepted as equivalent courses in Mercy's graduate degree programs upon acceptance and matriculation as a Mercy University student. Many of TEI's courses are cross-listed and automatically accepted as the same/equivalent of the course with which it is cross-listed.

Mercy University is chartered by the Board of Regents of the University of the State of New York, and accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools. It's School of Education is accredited by the Council for Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP).
